Indiana Puzzle

Here is another block that has been around for decades and is shown in many quilt block books.

Supplies
2 white 3 7/8 in squares
2 red 3 7/8 in squares
8 white 2 in squares
8 red 2 in squares
1 white 3 1/2 in square

With the 2 inch squares make 4 four patch blocks for the corners of your piece.





Draw a diagonal line across the 2 white 3 7/8 in squares. Put one white and one red square together. On each side of that line sew 1/4 inch seams. Cut down that line and press open to form 2 half square triangles.







Sew the block together as shown in the picture. with the 4 patches in the corners with the white squares always on the outermost corners. The half square triangles should form a star going around the center. The 3 1/2 in square is your center square.
